Pantry Ministry Update


Our Food Pantry is open on

From Our Pastor

Dear Church Family,

Since the governor of Texas will lift the Stay at Home order May 1 and will give an update around May 18, we will take a slow approach. We will continue with our Facebook stream Sunday, May 3. Watch the Sunday school lesson at 9:00 and the morning worship/message at 10:15. We will resume normal office hours starting Monday, May 4 through Thursday, but no Wednesday evening activities yet. Anyone who feels comfortable may return to the morning worship service on Mother's Day, May 10, at 10:15. We will practice social distancing, so no shaking hands or hugging. Provided that we hear favorable reports and updates during the following week, we may get back to Sunday school on May 17. We will wait for the next major update from the governor before we make plans to expand any further. We will also wait until mid-May to even think about opening the nursery.

To reduce the amount of disinfecting that our custodial staff will require, please use only the front glass doors of the worship center to enter and exit when you return to morning worship on Mother's Day. We will lock all other doors. Please use the automatic hand sanitizer dispensers on either side of the double doors as you enter and exit the worship center. They are located at each major entrance. Even better, wash your hands in the restrooms. We will tape off every other row in the worship center so that there will be an empty row ahead of you and behind you—ideally. Immediate families may sit together, especially those with small children, but please attempt to allow about 6 feet between you and others while seated (or about 3 seats between you and others). For now, we will have receptacles in the foyer where you can leave your tithes and offerings. However, you are still free to give online or mail to the church. We will probably have to do this for a little while, so please be patient.

We were scheduled to host a VBS clinic later in May, but stay tuned to see if it is still on or postponed. We are scheduled to have VBS here at the church during the first week of June. Whether or not we keep that date probably depends a lot on the mid-May update, but please be aware that we may need to reschedule. Contact Shawn Werley if you would like to volunteer to teach or work in VBS this summer.

As this COVID-19 situation continues to unfold, we will hope that it decreases very soon so that we can get back to our Wednesday and Sunday evening schedules. We will just watch the news and proceed according to recommendations.
