Our group will join a mission project and will conduct a vacation Bible school at an apartment complex in Brownsville, and minister to their families while sharing the gospel. They will have recreation, Bible stories, snacks, crafts, worship; and a message for the kids, parents, and siblings every evening. The group will have an opportunity to do things in Brownsville during the day and witness as they go.
